

Nondiscrimination - There shall be no discrimination against employees or applicants for employment on account of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, or any political or union affiliation. Also, no prohibition or discrimination shall take place against handicapped persons or prohibition or discrimination in accordance with the Age Discrimination Act or the Americans with Disabilities Act. This rule shall be in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. The Authority shall provide reasonable accommodations to qualified handicapped individuals. Persons with mental or physical disabilities are eligible as long as they can perform the essential functions of the job after reasonable accommodation is made to their known limitations. Employees who believe they are being discriminated against may bring their complaint to the attention of the Executive Director of the Housing Authority, Raymond H. Maier, or to the Chair of the Personnel Committee, James Hursey, of the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Bridgeton. The identities and functions of these persons with regard to claims of discrimination shall be made generally known by posting of their positions, functions and names on bulletin boards in conspicuous places or by placing them on the website of the Authority at bridgetonpha.org.
