

SEXUAL OR OTHER FORMS OF UNLAWFUL HARASSMENT

It is the policy of the Housing Authority of the City of Bridgeton that work place sexual harassment or other form of unlawful harassment is prohibited. All employees have the right to work in a harassment-free environment, and those persons who violate this policy will be disciplined. Any persons feeling they are being sexually harassed may report the harassment to their immediate supervisor unless the supervisor is the person who is harassing the employee in which case the matter may be taken to the Executive Director, Raymond H. Maier or to the Chairman, Robert Felmei or Vice-Chair, Tyrone Williams, of the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners as may be appropriate. Employees are encouraged to report sexual harassment or other form of unlawful harassment committed by others. The identities and functions of these persons with regard to claims of discrimination shall be made generally known by posting of their positions, functions and names on bulletin boards in conspicuous places or by placing them on the website of the Authority at bridgetonpha.org. Any employee reporting an act of sexual or other form of unlawful harassment, by another, will not be disciplined.
